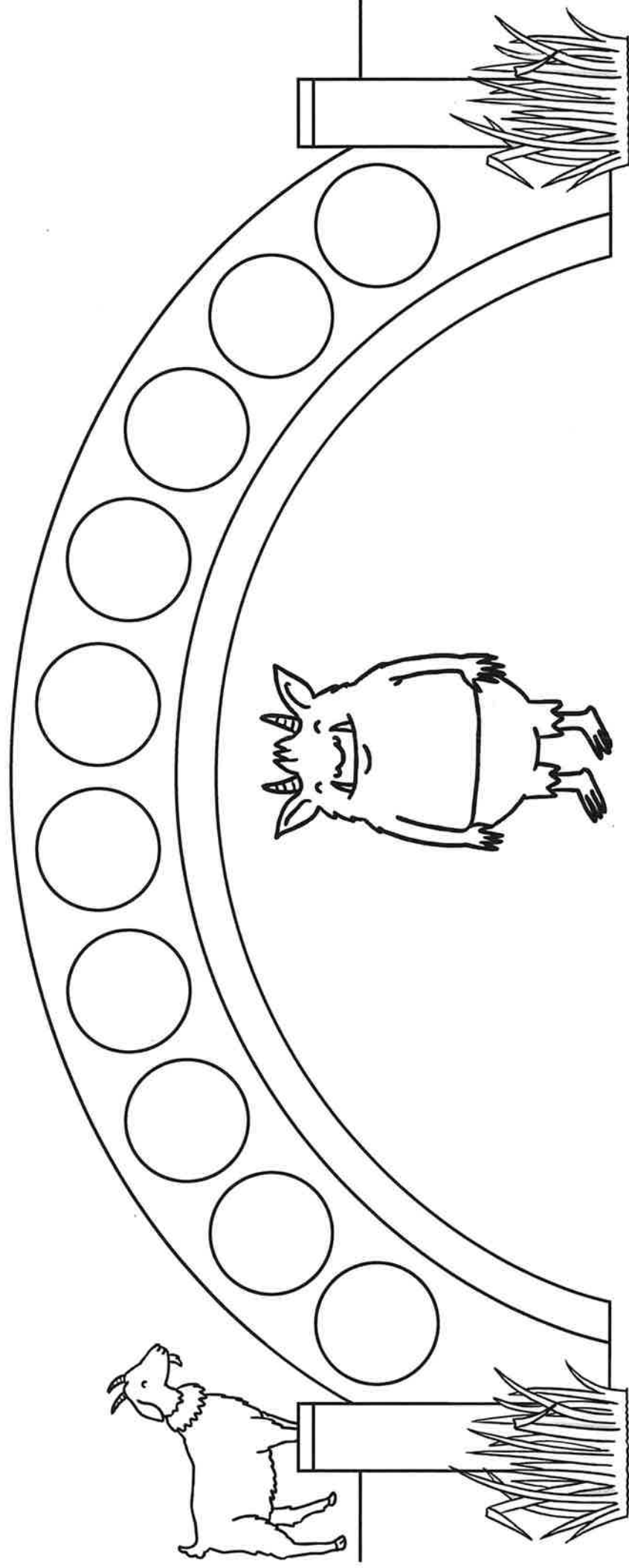
Easter Egg Repeating Patterns

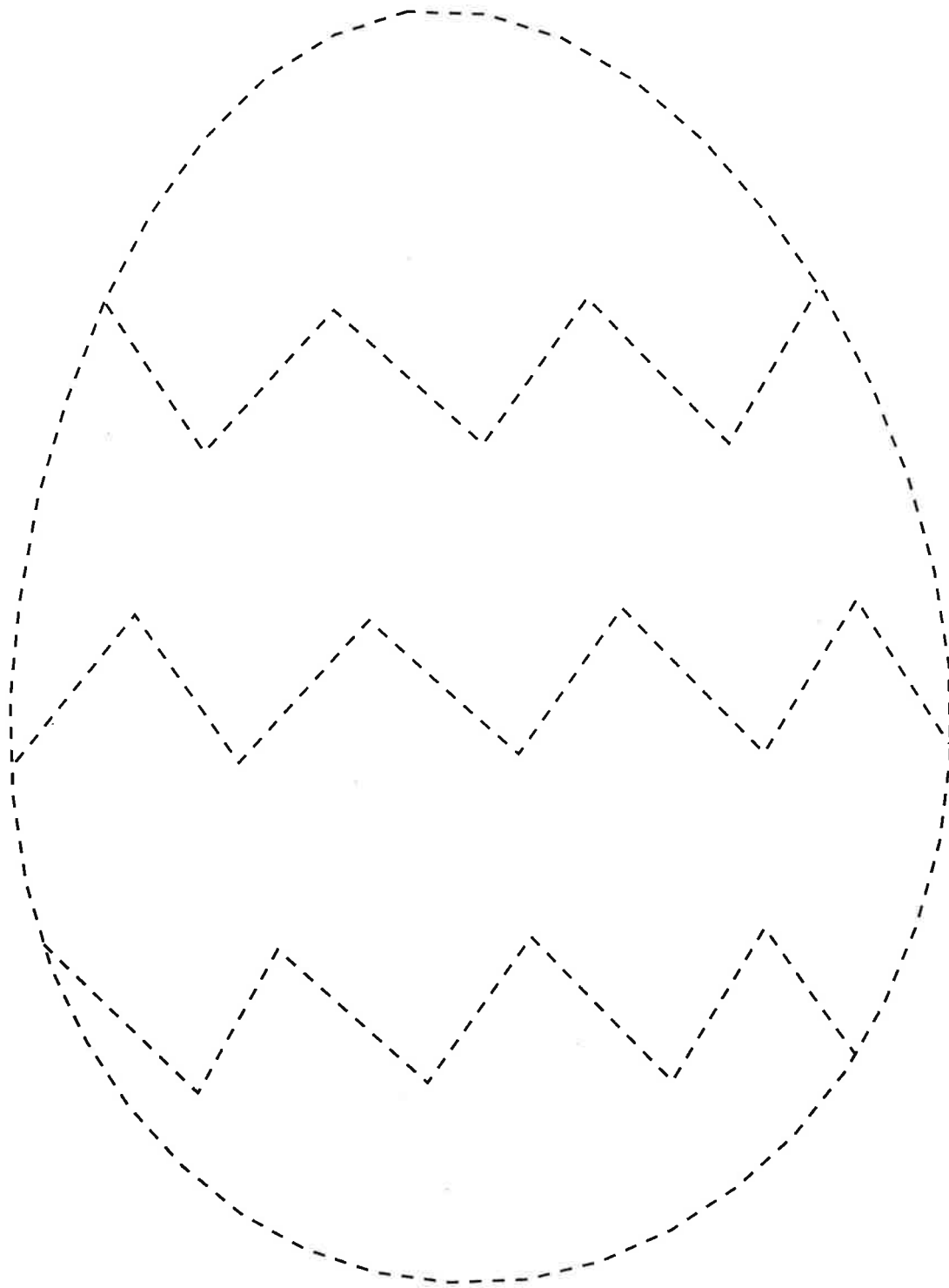
