WALKING TOGETHER TO AND FROM SCHOOL

1. Plan your trip to school so you are using pedestrian crossing areas where possible.
2. Always hold your child's hand up until the age of eight. Young children need your help to spot danger, for example vehicles coming out of driveways. Children can also be easily distracted and wander into traffic.
3. Drop off and pick up your child near the school gate and avoid calling them from across the road. Talk to your children about Stop, Look, Listen and Think every time they cross the road:
 - Stop one step back from the kerb
 - Look continuously both ways
 - Listen for the sounds of approaching traffic
 - Think whether it is safe to cross and keep checking until safely across

Your child's safety depends on you. Young children can learn these safe pedestrian habits from you and use them when they are old enough to travel alone.

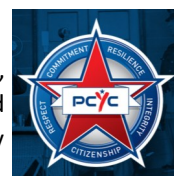
Confirmation this year will be held on **Sunday 5 August**.
