## PRIMARY ETHICS COORDINATOR AND TEACHERS NEEDED IN 2020

Primary Ethics has been offered to Year 1 and 2 classes at our school for the past two years. To be able to continue to offer this program we need new volunteer teachers and a coordinator.

The role of an Ethics teacher is to deliver lesson materials provided by Primary Ethics. Suitable volunteers must be available on Thursday at approximately 2:25pm for half an hour each school week. Volunteers receive full training which consists of a two-day workshop and short online modules.

The role of Ethics Coordinator is to communicate with school staff, support ethics teachers and liaise with Primary Ethics, the not-for-profit organisation approved to design curriculum and training for the program.
