HEAD LICE ALERT

The dreaded head lice are back!



Generally, where one student has head lice this serves as a warning that there is likely to be an infestation in either specific classes or across the whole school population.

Please check your child's hair on a daily basis and if you find head lice or their eggs treat them immediately. A commercial lice treatment (available from your local chemist or supermarket) can be effective, but you will need to read the label and follow the safety instructions carefully.



Always re-treat 7-10 days after the first treatment.
