CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

Advice from Parkes Shire Council

Construction for the Recycled Water Rising Main will progress past Parkes East Public School between **Tuesday 12 February and Thursday 21 February.**

During this period there will be minor delays, and traffic control will be in place.

The work will be undertaken along:

- Renshaw McGirr Way to the corner of Reid Street
- Reid Street, between Renshaw McGirr Way and East Street

Road and footpath closures are required to ensure public safety and ensure timely construction to minimise the duration of disruptions.

Parents and carers are urged to be extra vigilant around the school while road conditions are changed. Please follow directions from traffic controllers, and refrain from driving or parking along freshly laid pipe-works as this could pose safety risks to the pipes and vehicles.
