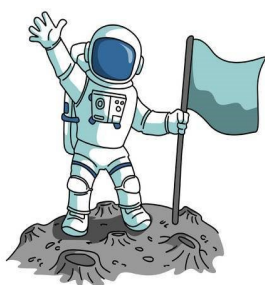

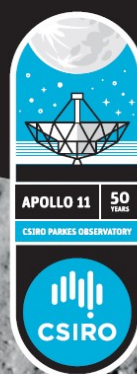
## NAIDOC CELEBRATIONS
