Please ensure children wear appropriate clothing to participate in these sessions.

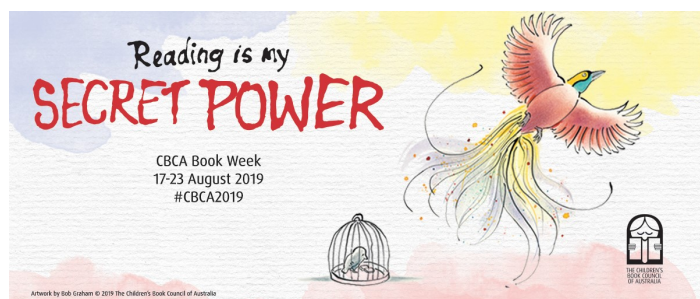


## BOYS HOCKEY

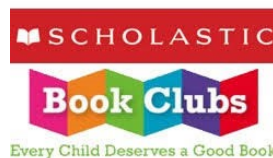


## BOOK WEEK

**Stage 2:** First "Came Here For Love" group

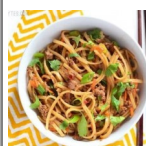
