




Award recipients have been sent invites and need to be in full school uniform. These students will have allocated seats for the ceremony.

SCHOOL HEALTH WARNINGS

The school has had several cases of Impetigo (school sores) reported.

Impetigo (school sores) is a highly contagious type of skin infection caused by Staphylococcus or Streptococcus bacteria. The infection is characterised by inflamed blisters that pop, weep and form crusts.

Whooping cough is also on the rise within our school community. Whooping cough (pertussis) is a highly contagious respiratory tract infection.

Please be vigilant if your child is unwell, as they may have been exposed to these infections.
