#### Important Health Notice: Chicken Pox Case

We wish to inform you that a case of chicken pox has been reported at our school. Chicken pox is a highly contagious viral infection that can spread easily among individuals who have not had the disease or have not been vaccinated.

To ensure the health and safety of all students, we recommend the following:

- Monitor Symptoms: Please keep an eye on your child for any symptoms, which may include fever, tiredness, loss of appetite, and a distinctive rash that develops into fluid-filled blisters.
- Vaccination: If your child has not been vaccinated against chicken pox, we encourage you to discuss vaccination options with your healthcare provider.
- Stay home if sick: If your child develops chicken pox, please keep them at home until all blisters have crusted over, typically about 5 to 7 days after the rash appears.
- Inform the School: If your child is diagnosed with chicken pox, please notify the school as soon as possible.

Our priority is to maintain a safe environment for all students. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact the school office.
